## BUS SERVICES - SCHOOLS

326. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:
(1) When a bus with a maximum licensed capacity of 64 passengers operates as a school special bus, how many students are permitted to travel on that bus?
(2) When a bus with a maximum licensed capacity of 110 passengers operates as a school special bus, how many students are permitted to travel on that bus?

## Hon DONNA FARAGHER replied:

On behalf of the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport, I thank the member for some notice of the question.
(1) A Transperth bus licensed to carry 64 passengers can carry 64 students when operating as a school bus special.
(2) A Transperth bus licensed to carry 110 passengers can carry 110 students when operating as a school bus special.
