

GERALDTON FIRE STATION — ASBESTOS REMOVAL

**570. Hon MATT BENSON-LIDHOLM to the minister representing the Minister for Emergency Services:**

- (1) Is the minister aware that there is asbestos in the Geraldton fire station that requires removal?
- (2) Has a schedule been set for that to occur?

**Hon PETER COLLIER replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question. On behalf of the Minister for Emergency Services I provide the following response —

- (1) I am advised by the Fire and Emergency Services Authority of Western Australia that the asbestos review for the Geraldton career fire station was undertaken, and Building Management and Works assessed Geraldton station as low risk.
- (2) FESA has scheduled the required works in its maintenance program.
