

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, WRITTEN POLICY ON PAYMENT OF
MEMBERSHIPS TO CLUBS/ASSOCIATIONS

1549. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection

- (1) For all Government departments or agencies within the Minister's portfolio, will the Minister advise if there is a written policy in respect of payments of memberships to a club/association for a member of staff since the February State Election of 2001?
