

LANDCORP - BUSSELTON LAND SALES AND DEVELOPMENTS

982. Hon NIGEL HALLETT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

I refer to the state government's proposal to develop and sell certain parcels of land in Busselton, part proceeds of which will fund the state's proposed \$6 million contribution to the upgrade of the Busselton jetty.

- (1) How much has LandCorp allocated in its project feasibility to facilitate the relocation of the existing users of Churchill Park, including the agricultural association, junior soccer, senior soccer, and the trotting club?
- (2) What is LandCorp's position if the actual cost of the relocation exceeds the project cost?

Hon ADELE FARINA replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) LandCorp has made indicative estimates of the financial provision required to replace existing club and sporting facilities with contemporary buildings that will provide like-for-like fixtures and amenity to those currently enjoyed by those community groups. The dollar amounts are fluid, as discussions with these groups are ongoing.
- (2) When the project has been agreed to by all parties, LandCorp will undertake final costings for replacement of the facilities.
