

SWAN VALLEY PLANNING ACT — PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

Petition

HON MATT BENSON-LIDHOLM (Agricultural) [10.35 am]: I present a petition containing 1 560 signatures couched in the following terms —

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to any changes to The Swan Valley Planning Act of 1995 relating to Sub division of land involving a reduction to minimum lot sizes within the boundaries of the current Swan Valley Planning Act. Sub division with any reduction of minimum lot sizes will impact not only on viticulture and rural lifestyle but threatens the amenity and the future of the Swan Valley as one of Perth's iconic tourism destinations.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to support the current Swan Valley Planning Act of 1995 without any changes relating to sub division of land and minimum lot sizes.
