**264. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Environment:**

What funds have been allocated in the 2010–11 budget for the establishment of the Camden Sound marine park?

**Hon DONNA FARAGHER replied:**

I thank the member for her question.

Camden Sound is obviously part of the Kimberley science and conservation strategy, which is a \$9 million commitment by this government. I am very pleased to say, as was mentioned in the Treasurer's speech earlier today, that Camden Sound will be the first marine park in the Kimberley region. The Kimberley science and conservation strategy will be released soon, and I will be very proud to release it.
