- (5)-(6) The Government has recently announced the construction of Greenwood Station. This is expected to relieve the parking pressure on Warwick Train Station by providing 660 new car bays.

The Development of a multi-storey car park at Warwick was examined in the past and 420 car bays could be created. However, there would likely be a strong local opposition from residents and significant disruption to the current parking areas during construction.
