459. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Environment:

- (1) On how many occasions has the minister met, either formally or informally, with Ms Cheryl Edwardes since the state election?
- (2) Is Ms Edwardes providing advice to the minister on the performance of her ministerial or political duties?
- (3) Did Ms Edwardes recommend or suggest the appointment of the minister's principal policy officer, Simon Taylor?
- (4) Is the minister aware that Ms Edwardes is an environmental lawyer with Minter Ellison handling environmental approval matters for her clients?
- (5) Is this not yet another example of the minister's susceptibility to conflict of interest matters?

The PRESIDENT: The last part of the question is out of order.

Hon DONNA FARAGHER replied:

I thank the member for her question. I am going to ask that the question be placed on notice.
