## 396. Hon BARRY HOUSE to the Minister for Education and Training:

Mr President -

Hon Ljiljanna Ravlich: He has already asked about six questions!

**Hon Ken Travers**: It's the only work he does in his shadow portfolio, so give him a break.

Hon BARRY HOUSE: The minister reckons that I do not do anything, because I do not have a web site.

**The PRESIDENT:** Hon Barry House has the call, so he should ask the question.

Hon BARRY HOUSE: I ask -

- (1) Which schools will receive an upgrade to art and craft and music facilities in 2005-06?
- (2) If Churchlands Senior High School, which is a specialist music school, is not one of those schools, is an upgrade planned for that school during the current term of the government?
- (3) If not, why not?

## Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) Coolbellup Community School and Manjimup Primary School will receive upgrades. The replacement school at Denham will also be provided with art and craft facilities.
- (2)-(3) Due to other competing demands, no provision for this has been made in the Department of Education and Training's forward estimates. Under Labor's \$1 billion plan for new and better schools, \$300 million has been allocated for upgrades over the next four years. Decisions on expenditure will be made in each school year.
