4227. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister for Water:

I refer to the proposed preventative program of air scouring and flushing of water mains in Beechboro that the Minister outlined in her letter dated 16 February 2015 and I ask:

- (a) when will the program begin;
- (b) how much will the program cost;
- (c) what is the criteria being used to assess the success of the program; and
- (d) if considered successful, when will a decision be made to extend the program to Morley, Noranda and Bennett Springs?

Ms M.J. Davies replied:

- (a) The program began in May 2015.
- (b) \$219 878
- (c) The level of customer contact regarding discoloured water in Beechboro.
- (d) A decision to extend the program to Morley and Noranda areas has been made. Work in Morley was completed at the end of June 2015. Work started in the Noranda area on 1 July 2015. A decision on the Bennett Springs area will be made by the end of June 2016.
