2824. Hon Nigel Hallett to the Minister for Education and Training

I refer to \$362,000 in 'top up' funding for -

- (a) Goollelal Primary School;
- (b) Greenwood Senior High School;
- (c) Halidon Primary School;
- (d) Hawker Primary and Pre Primary; and
- (e) West Greenwood Primary School,

and ask -

- (1) For each of the above schools -
 - (a) how much of the \$362 000 'top up' funding did each school receive; and
 - (b) detail whether the 'top up' funding was State funding and if so, specifically detail how much State funding each school received?
- (2) Were any other schools across Western Australia given 'top up' funding?
- (3) If yes to (2) above, please state -
 - (a) the names of the schools;
 - (b) the amount of 'top up' funding given;
 - (c) whether the 'top-up' funding was State money and if so, specifically detail how much of the 'top up' funding was State funding; and
 - (d) the State electorates these schools are located?

Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

I assume the 'top up' funding referred to in the question is the \$65 million Fixing our Schools program that forms part of the Carpenter Government's \$1 billion commitment to building new schools and upgrading existing schools.
