

CRIMINAL INJURIES COMPENSATION SCHEME — REVIEW

Question without Notice 290 — Supplementary Information

HON MATTHEW SWINBOURN (East Metropolitan — Parliamentary Secretary) [5.06 pm]: Further to the answer to Hon Nick Goiran's question without notice 290 asked on 17 June 2021, and following some discussions behind the chair, I provide the following supplementary information on behalf of the Attorney General.

I confirm the development of a business case was approved on 21 September 2017. During the development of this business case, it was determined that a discussion paper and review report should be considered in place of a business case. This discussion paper and review report led to the tabling of the *Report on the findings of the review of the criminal injuries compensation scheme in Western Australia* in Parliament on 11 February 2020. The review recommended that the criminal injuries compensation scheme be amended in accordance with the recommendations set out in the review and that a business case and cabinet submission be prepared. The Department of Justice is working on a proposal with respect to this business case. It will seek the Attorney General's approval to develop this business case in due course.
