- (1) What was the last count of traffic on South Western Highway around the Byford town centre prior to the opening of the Perth-Bunbury highway?
- What traffic counts have been taken on the South Western Highway since the opening of the Perth-Bunbury highway?
- (3) Will the minister table those counts?

- · South Western Highway North of Old Bunbury Rd
- · An 80 count site collection program will take place in March 2010.
