

Division 54: Western Australian Planning Commission -

Question: Mrs Edwardes, referring to the general reference to statutory planning at page 924, asked the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure whether the status of the right of way in the middle of the former Scarborough Beach High School land had changed in the course of the statutory planning processes underway in relation to that land.

Answer: The “right of way” is Crown (Footway) Reserve 25608. The Department of Land Administration (DOLA) is the authority responsible for the closure of Reserves. On 21 August 2001, the City of Stirling resolved that DOLA be requested to effect closure of Footway Reserve 25608 between Jackson Avenue and Newborough Street, Karrinyup and amalgamation of the resultant land into adjoining land parcels. DOLA closed the reserve in August 2001.

Question: Mrs Edwardes, referring to the “Salaries and Allowances” item at page 935, asked the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure for a breakdown of that figure.

Answer: The \$3.382 million in budgeted salaries and allowances expenses comprises -
