## RETAIL WORKERS — ASSAULT — CRIMINAL CODE AMENDMENT BILL 2024

## 150. Hon TJORN SIBMA to the parliamentary secretary representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the Criminal Code Amendment Bill 2024.

- (1) Is the owner of a retail business also included in the scope of the new offence of assault on a retail worker as they are
  - (a) likely to be engaged in duties that are not ordinarily considered part of the "day-to-day operations of the business"; and
  - (b) not under the "control and direction" of the business when they are within their retail business premises?
- (2) If not, why not?
