HISMELT PROJECT, GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE

- 1020. Mr L. Graham to the Minister for State Development
- (1) What State Government assistance has been provided for the Rio Tinto Hismelt project?
- (2) What is the purpose of providing the assistance?
- (3) What is the total cost to the State Government of providing the assistance?
- (4) Did the Government offer the assistance in the first instance?
- (5) If the answer to (4) is yes, specifically why was the assistance offered?
- (6) Specifically what does the State get in return for the assistance offered?
- (7) If the answer to (4) is no, who asked that any assistance be offered?
- (8) How will the value or benefit to the State of the assistance be measured?
- (9) Who will measure the value or benefit to the State of the assistance?
- (10) From where can a copy of the relevant Government policy be obtained in which the conditions for granting this kind of assistance to companies are outlined?
- (11) Which other companies have received similar assistance in the last five years?

Mr C.M. BROWN replied:

I am advised that:

- (1) The Office of Major Projects (OMP) has facilitated the project. LandCorp has provided a commercial lease and Fremantle Port Authority (FPA) has contracted to provide port services on a commercial basis.
- (2) To facilitate downstream processing of the State's iron ore within the State and thus gain all the economic and other benefits that arise from such developments.
- (3) The HIsmelt project will take place on the former BHP Billiton site at Kwinana which was acquired by FPA and LandCorp. The port facilities and land acquired by FPA are being used for the handling of bulk commodities for a range of customers and will also be used for handling of HIsmelt products. Part of the land acquired by LandCorp is leased to HIsmelt at commercial rates. Part is leased to several heavy industry users with the balance to be leased out to future appropriate heavy industry users.
 - The cost of facilitation services to the project is essentially restricted to salary costs in various agencies.
- (4) Facilitation by OMP was sought by HIsmelt.
- (5) N/A.
- (6) A HIsmelt plant is partial fulfilment of an objective of successive governments of value adding to the State's iron ore and the potential to expand this valuable industry in Western Australia and ensuring appropriate and productive use of this strategic heavy industrial land.
- (7) Facilitation was initiated following an approach by the proponent.
- (8) By a variety of measures including tax income, unemployment measures, impact on the State's GDP, and other relevant measures.
- (9) Treasury and other relevant Government Departments.
- (10) The conditions in which Government provides assistance to companies varies according to the circumstances in which the assistance is given and are not contained within a single policy document.
