

LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY, REVIEW

538. Hon Barry House to the Minister for Racing and Gaming

- (1) Has the Minister commenced a review of the Liquor Licensing Authority?
- (2) If so, what is the purpose of the review?
- (3) Who is conducting the review?
- (4) What feedback has been sought from stakeholders and the public, in conducting the review?
- (5) When does the Government intend tabling recommendations arising from the review of the Liquor Licensing Authority?

Hon NICK GRIFFITHS replied:

A Discussion Paper was issued in July 2002 inviting submissions on a review of the structure and operation of the licensing authority, which is constituted by the Liquor Licensing Court or the Director of Liquor Licensing.
