## 304. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

I refer to train services on the Midland, Joondalup, Fremantle, Mandurah and Armadale lines.

- (1) What is the average number of carriages on trains travelling on each of these lines between the hours of
  - (a) 7.00 am and 9.00 am to Perth; and
  - (b) 4.30 pm and 6.00 pm from Perth each weekday?
- (2) How many train services are provided on each of these lines during the travel periods referred to in (1)?
- What is the current average number of passengers travelling on each of these lines during the travel periods referred to in (1)?
