## 232. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Environment:

Does the minister have confidence in the Department of Environment and Conservation's management of and involvement in logging in designated coupes in the South West Region?

## Hon DONNA FARAGHER replied:

I thank you, Mr President, for your advice in relation to the question.

Can I just say that the Department of Environment and Conservation operates under the forest management plan? As well, as in relation to matters surrounding logging, it obviously has a great deal of involvement with the Forest Products Commission, and I do have confidence that the department does do the right thing.
