Earlier this year I lost one of my employees to another office and as a result of that departure I restructured in the office, changed duties, reviewed some of our processes and procedures and we have moved more towards electronic transfer of information between our office and agencies and we have been able to maintain output with a reduced budget and a reduced FTF
