## DISTRICT COURT AMENDMENT RULES 2022

815. Hon Nick Goiran to the parliamentary secretary representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the District Court Amendment Rules 2022, and I ask:

- (a) what was the catalyst for bringing about these amendments to the rules;
- (b) who was consulted prior to these amendment rules being finalised;
- (c) did any person consulted raise any concerns;
- (d) if yes to, what were these concerns;
- (e) have the finalised amendment rules addressed these concerns; and
- (f) if no to (e), why not?

## Hon Matthew Swinbourn replied:

- (a) The amendments arose as a consequence of the Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2022 repealing the Legal Profession Act 2008 and introducing the Legal Profession Uniform Law scheme in Western Australia. This necessitated amendments to the District Court Rules 2005.
- (b) The State Solicitor's Office consulted with the Chief Justice of the District Court of Western Australia in relation to these consequential amendments, prior to Her Honour making the amendment rules.
