- It be recognized that Tuart College currently services in excess of 2,500 students from the Northern and Western Suburbs of the Metro area.
- 2. The student population is such that the majority are required to utilize Public Transport and are being severely disadvantaged by a lack of appropriate access to the system.
- 3. The simple solutions exist in re-routing the 'Circle Routes' 98-99 Service, to within reasonable walking distance of the college.
- 4. That the responsible minister be requested to consider appropriate changes to the current system.
