## BUILDING INDUSTRY AND SPECIAL PROJECTS INSPECTORATE, GUIDELINES

- 317. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for Labour Relations
- (1) What instructions, practices, policies, guidelines, and/or procedures have been issued to the new Building Industry and Special Projects Inspectorate to carry out their role/functions of investigating illegal activity on building sites and/or other complaints?
- (2) Will the Minister table the items referred to in(1)?
- (3) If not, what has been put in place for them to determine their role/functions, and how they will carry it out?

## Mr KOBELKE replied:

- (1) The Building Industry and Special Projects Inspectorate (BISPI) is a branch of the Fair Workplaces Division of the Department of Productivity and Labour Relations (DOPLAR). A specific instruction issued by the Acting Chief Executive Officer for BISPI officers, covers their specific role and complaints procedure. This instruction is supplemented by the existing compliance policies and procedures of the Division.
- (2) I table the BISPI instruction and extracts from the Fair Workplaces compliance procedures in relation to Prosecution Policy and the Investigation Process for Part VIA of the Industrial Relations Act [See paper No 314.]
