GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, REDEPLOYMENT REGISTRATION REQUESTS

2546. Mrs C.L. Edwardes to the Premier

I refer the Premier to the 2002/2003 Annual Report of the Department of Premier and Cabinet and ask -

- how many redeployment registration requests have been dealt with since the changes were put in place;
- (b) for each request, what was the reason for the request, which department did they originate from, what was the intended destination and was the request successful; and
- (c) of the unsuccessful requests, how many of these positions were filled by redeployees?

Dr G.I. GALLOP replied:

- (a) From 1 July 2002 to 9 March 2004 a total of 356 requests to centrally register public sector employees for redeployment were accepted. Central records are not available to show the total number of redeployment registration requests made, including those that were not accepted.
- (b) A listing of the 356 accepted registrations is attached showing the referring agency and the broad reasoning for each application. [See paper No 2230.]
