## SAFER WA COMMUNITY SECURITY PROGRAM, FUNDING FOR CITIES OF SWAN AND BAYSWATER

282. Mr J.B. D'Orazio to the Minister representing the Minister for Local Government and Regional Development

I refer to the recently announced grants for the SAFER WA Community Security Program 2001-2002 and ask -

- (a) were funds provided to the City of Swan;
- (b) were funds provided to the City of Bayswater;
- (c) how much was provided specifically for areas of Ballajura, Malaga, Beechboro, Morley and Noranda;
- (d) what was the value of the grants; and
- (e) for what purpose were the funds awarded?

## Ms A.J. MacTIERNAN replied:

- (a) Yes, funds were provided to improve safety in the City of Swan.
- (b) No, funds were not provided to the City of Bayswater.
- (c) \$10,000 was provided specifically for the areas of Ballajura, Malaga and Beechboro.
- (d) The City of Swan received a total of \$50,000 towards two projects (\$10,000 and \$40,000).
- (e) The purpose of the funds awarded were:
  - · \$10,000 towards conducting a security audit for Ballajura, Malaga and Beechboro; and
  - · \$40,000 towards the increased hours of operation of the Swan Patrol Services.
