

ENVIRONMENT — CONSERVATION PARKS AND RESERVES

**541. Hon TJORN SIBMA to the minister representing the Minister for Environment:**

I refer to the government's Plan for Our Parks policy.

- (1) What are the resourcing implications of the additional five million hectares of conservation estate that the government proposes to deliver?
- (2) How does this compare with the resourcing of the existing conservation estate?
- (3) How does the government intend to fund the management of a 20 per cent increase to the size of Western Australia's conservation estate?
