We, the undersigned acknowledge the growth of population in the northern suburbs, and the impact this has on the use of the rail transport system. The train stations along the northern railway line are particularly congested and a lack of car park spaces is extremely frustrating for commuters.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to remedy this situation by providing extra car parking facilities at the Edgewater Train Station, as well as additional Smart Rider machines to process public fares.
