

ROYAL COMMISSION INTO WHETHER THERE HAS BEEN ANY CORRUPT OR CRIMINAL
CONDUCT BY WESTERN AUSTRALIAN POLICE OFFICERS, LEGAL REPRESENTATION FOR
PUBLIC OFFICERS

661. Hon DERRICK TOMLINSON to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

- (1) Which public officers, including police officers and members of Parliament, called to appear before the Royal Commission Into Whether There Has Been Any Corrupt or Criminal Conduct by Western Australian Police Officers, were granted financial assistance for legal representation?
- (2) What sum was granted to each officer?
- (3) Were any public officers who were not called to appear granted financial assistance to engage legal counsel to represent their interests before the royal commission?
- (4) If yes, who were those persons and what sum was each granted?
