SCHOOLS, FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES, NORTH WEST

1036. Mr L. Graham to the Minister for Education and Training

I refer to the recent announcement that nearly 200 students with intellectual disabilities will benefit from more than \$1.5million in State Government funding this financial year to upgrade their educational facilities, and I ask

- (a) how much of the proposed \$1.5million is to be spent on upgrading facilities for students with intellectual disabilities in the North West of the State;
- (b) in which towns and communities will the funds be spent;
- (c) who will be responsible for administering the funds; and
- (d) when will the programs commence operation in each town referred to above?

Mr A.J. CARPENTER replied:

(a)-(d) None of the schools, at which upgrading work is to be undertaken, is located in the North West of the State.
