5093. Ms L.L. Baker to the Minister for Sport and Recreation:

- (1) For the following years, what was the total amount spent in the State Sport and Recreation budget, excluding any Commonwealth funding or funded programs, on programs and delivery of services for the prenatal period and for children in Western Australia from birth to age three, respectively:
 - (a) 2012–2013;
 - (b) 2013–2014;
 - (c) 2014–2015; and
 - (d) 2015–2016?
- (2) For the following years, what percentage of the State Sport and Recreation budget, excluding any Commonwealth funding or funded programs, was spent on programs and delivery of services for the prenatal period, and for children in Western Australia from birth to age three, respectively:
 - (a) 2012–2013;
 - (b) 2013–2014;
 - (c) 2014–2015; and
 - (d) 2015–2016?
- (3) For the following years, which programs have been funded wholly by the State Sport and Recreation budget for the prenatal period and for zero to three-year-olds, respectively:
 - (a) 2012–2013;
 - (b) 2013–2014;
 - (c) 2014–2015; and
 - (d) 2015–2016?
- (4) For the following years, which programs and services have been funded wholly or in part by the State Sport and Recreation budget for the prenatal period and for zero to three-year-olds, respectively:
 - (a) 2012–2013;
 - (b) 2013–2014;
 - (c) 2014–2015; and
 - (d) 2015–2016?
