

FRANCHISING BILL 2010

Precedence of Business — Standing Orders Suspension — Notice of Motion

Mr P. Abetz gave notice that at the next sitting of the house he would move —

That so much of standing orders be suspended as is necessary to require by this motion that —

- (a) the order of the day for the Franchising Bill 2010 take precedence over all other items of government business and private members' business until it has been finally dealt with in the Legislative Assembly; and
- (b) the Franchising Bill 2010 proceed without delay between the stages.
