# **Water Corporation**

(a)—(d) The Water Corporation charges are billed over the financial year period, not the calendar year. Until 1 July 2013, the Corporation could only provide yearly totals for pension and concession rebates. From 1 July 2013, a change in billing method (two monthly billing) enabled the Corporation to provide concessions and rebates details on a monthly basis. Western Australian Senior Card Holders and Commonwealth Seniors Health Card Holders are not eligible for a water use concession — only a service charges rebate.
