1323. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection

I refer the Minister to the list of Employee Organisations and ask -

- (e) if no to (c) and yes to (d), what action can the Minister take and what action does the Minister intend to take on this issue; and
- (f) if moneys have been collected and used, what action can the Minister take and what action does the Minister intend to take on this issue?
