He was also captain of the Western Australian state rifle team in 1978, 1979, 1982, 1984, 1986 and 1988. Dennis worked on the wharf at Geraldton and was a Greenough councillor. I have known him for some years. He is a great representative of his sport, and he has continued to support and be involved with his club over many years.
