

EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE AGREEMENTS, REGISTRAR'S DETERMINATIONS

1488. Mrs C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection

I refer the Minister to Employer-Employee agreements as provided for under the *Industrial Relations Act 1979*, and ask -

- (a) has the Registrar made determinations as to relevant awards, orders, comparable awards pursuant to Section 97VS;
- (b) if so, is this information available publicly, and if so, where; and if not, why not;
- (c) has the Registrar made any determinations of award, comparable award or relevant order pursuant to section 97VT;
- (d) if so, is this information available publicly, and if so where; and if not, why not;
- (e) are there applications for a determination by the Registrar under Section 97VT; and
- (f) if so, how many, and for which industries, and/or occupations are they, when were each of these applications made, and when is it likely that a determination will be made?
