For all departments, agencies and statutory authorities under the control of the Deputy Premier, what was the leave liability (annual and long service) for the financial year 2001-2002?

Department of Treasury and Finance

The total cost of leave liability to 30 June 2002 was \$6,419,728.

WA Treasury Corporation

The leave liability as at 30 June 2002 was \$1,599,000 (which was an increase of \$209,000 from the previous year). This amount has been fully provided for and disclosed within the Corporations financial statements.
