

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, CREDITORS

1529. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister representing the Minister for Housing and Works; Local Government and Regional Development; the Kimberley, Pilbara and Gascoyne

For each Department and Agency within the Minister's portfolio, will the Minister provide from each agency or department financial system -

- (a) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for less than or equal to 30 days, as at 30 June 2001;
- (b) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 30 days and less than or equal to 60 days, as at 30 June 2001;
- (c) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 60 days and less than or equal to 90 days, as at 30 June 2001;
- (d) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 90 days and less than or equal to 120 days, as at 30 June 2001;
- (e) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 120days, as at 30 June 2001;
- (f) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for less than or equal to 30 days, as at 30 June 2002;
- (g) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 30 days and less than or equal to 60 days, as at 30 June 2002;
- (h) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 60 days and less than or equal to 90 days, as at 30 June 2002;
- (i) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 90 days and less than or equal to 120 days, as at 30 June 2002; and
- (j) the amount and number of creditors outstanding for greater than 120days, as at 30 June 2002?
