

HERITAGE, NATIONAL TRUST, MAJOR RESTORATION WORKS

1098. Mr Edwards to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

In reference to the National Trust's Major Achievements for 2000/01 listed on page 757 of the Budget Estimates for 2001/02, I ask the Minister -

- (a) given that the twelve properties listed as having major restoration works were also listed in the Major Achievements for 1999/2000 in the area of major restoration, what works were carried out in the 2000/01 year that were different to the major restoration works listed for the previous year;
- (b) given that the eleven Conservation Plans listed as being achieved in 2000/01 were also listed as being achieved in 1999/2000, were Conservation Plans prepared for each of these places each year;
- (c) if not, why were they listed as achievements in both years;
- (d) given that the minor restoration and repairs identified as achievements in the year 2000/01 were also listed as achievements in the year 1999/2000, what works were carried out in each financial year for the properties listed; and
- (e) given that the achievements listed under the heading 'Additions/Upgrades' for the year 2000/01 are the same as those listed in the previous year, how can this repetition of achievements be explained?
