2		This is the Reserves (Wanjarri Nature Reserve) Act 2011.

4		This Act comes into operation as follows —
5 6		(a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
7		(b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.
8	3.	Reserve 30897 amended
9	(1)	In this section —
10 11 12 13 14		affected reserve means Reserve 30897, being Lot 122 on Deposited Plan 220708 and being the whole of the land in Certificate of Crown Land Title Volume LR3116 Folio 796, that is classified under the Land Administration Act 1997 as a class A reserve;
15 16		<i>excision area</i> means the area of about 758 hectares identified as the Excision Area on Deposited Plan 72976;
17 18		<b>Registrar</b> means the Registrar of Titles referred to in the <i>Transfer of Land Act 1893</i> section 7.
19	(2)	The affected reserve is amended by excising the excision area.
20 21	(3)	Immediately after the excision area is excised from the affected reserve —
22		(a) the area ceases to be classified as a class A reserve; and
23 24		(b) the area becomes reserved to the Crown for the purpose of mining; and
25 26 27		(c) the care, control and management of the reserve created by paragraph (b) is placed with the corporation sole established by the <i>Mining Act 1978</i> section 10(2),
28		for the purposes of the Land Administration Act 1997 Part 4.
