***TOBACCO PRODUCTS CONTROL AMENDMENT BILL 2017 [28-1]***

When in committee on the *Tobacco Products Control Amendment Bill 2017*:

**Clause 2**

**Hon Rick Mazza:** To move —

2/2 Page 2, line 7 — To delete “24 months” and insert:

5 years

**Clause 6**

**Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Health:** To move —

1/6 Page 3, line 21 to page 5, line 17 — To delete the lines and insert:

**6. Section 23 amended**

(1) After section 23(1) insert:

- (2) If a person is charged with an offence under section 22(1) it is a defence to prove that at the time the offence is alleged to have been committed —
- (a) the person was a specialist retailer; and
  - (b) the display was of a cigar or an implement designed to cut a cigar; and
  - (c) the display could not be seen from a public place outside the premises specified in the licence; and

- (d) a health warning sign in accordance with the regulations was displayed immediately adjacent to the display.

- (2) Delete section 23(4).
