EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

RAILWAY (JANDAKOT TO PERTH) BILL 2002

The purpose of this Bill is to authorise the construction of a railway from Jandakot to Perth.

This new railway will be an extension of the urban passenger railway network and will provide for a new urban passenger railway service to operate from Perth to Mandurah via Jandakot, Kwinana and Rockingham.

Following are the contents of the Bill, described clause by clause:

- Section 1: The short title of the Bill.
- Section 2: This section provides that the proposed Act will come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- Section 3: This section gives the authority to construct the proposed Jandakot to Perth section of railway.

The authority extends to construction and maintenance of the proposed railway with all the proper and usual works and facilities along the line which is specified in the schedule to the Bill.

Schedule 1: This schedule sets out the line of the proposed Jandakot to Perth section of railway.
