**A Bill for**

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2010.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

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1    **1.       Short title**

2                   This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Capital*  
3                   *2009-10 Act 2009*.

4    **2.       Commencement**

5                   This Act comes into operation as follows —

- 6                   (a)   sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act  
7                   receives the Royal Assent;  
8                   (b)   the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9    **3.       Issue and application of moneys**

10           (1)   The sum of \$3 576 776 000 is to be issued and may be applied  
11           out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year  
12           from 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010.

13           (2)   The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply  
14           granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Recurrent*  
15           *2009-10 Act 2009*.

16   **4.       Appropriation for capital purposes**

17                   The sum of \$3 576 776 000 granted by section 3 as supply is  
18                   appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital  
19                   purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency  
20                   Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
