The following information in relation to your below query has been approved by the Commissioner:

To clarify this statement, 'For the new gas power plant being developed, Ratch Australia Diesel Kemerton, a FES-ERG will be prepared.' Should read 'For the Ratch Australia Diesel Kemerton gas power plant, an initial FES-ERG will be prepared.'

Background

- The Ratch Australia Diesel Kemerton gas plant is not new or expanded in size.
- After the 2014 amendment of the Dangerous Goods Regulations 2007, FES-ERG's became a legal requirement for sites such as Ratch Australia which exceeded 10 times the manifest quantity of Dangerous Goods license.
- The Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety, as the regulator and issuer of Dangerous Goods
 Licenses, began to provide DFES with consolidated lists, indicating sites that required FES-ERGS in October
 2016
- Ratch Australia is required to prepare or revise the FESERG in consultation with DFES.
