Inquiry into the Implications for Western Australia of Hydraulic Fracturing for Unconventional Gas – Transcript of Evidence

I enclose a copy of the transcript, with errors marked up by hand.

At the end of my first sentence, I had intended to say 'for unconventional gas'. This would be in the written version of my opening statement that I handed to the Committee. I am not sure whether this was missed by the stenographer, or I omitted to say it.

On page 8, in the fourth full paragraph, the transcript records "...not a single one of them has grown within more than a couple of thousand feet in terms of fracture height. On reading the transcript, I have realised this is a little unclear. It would be clearer if it said "...not a single one of them has grown within more than a couple of thousand feet from drinking water aquifers in terms of fracture height". Can the additional words be inserted for clarity's sake?
