The Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation will be holding public hearings as part of its inquiry into access to Australian Standards adopted in delegated legislation.

The hearings will be held at the **Legislative Council Committee Office**, **Ground Floor**, **18-32 Parliament Place**, **West Perth** and open to the general public.

This inquiry arose out of the Committee's observation that delegated legislation (including rules, regulations and local government local laws) frequently adopt Australian Standards, but those Standards are not accessible free of charge to the public, or the Parliament, in the same way that primary and secondary legislation is publicly available.

Peter Abetz MLA, Chairman of the Committee said:

"It is a feature of the rule of law that the law in question must be capable of being known by everyone, so that everyone can comply with it. As well as being clear and certain, that law must be readily available."
