I can hear the pain in my parents voices when they say they wished they could see their grandkids more often! It is cheaper for them to drive then fly but that is becoming impossible for them now because of their age.

I understand why so many people move away from the Kimberley, so that they can enjoy the cheaper cost of living and airfares that the rest of Australia takes for granted.
