### Good afternoon,

I wish to express my concern in regards to the cost of flights to get to/from Kununurra, regional western Australia.

The cost of flights often equates to sacrificing significant events and milestones, to get to and from Kununurra often costs in excess of \$1000

Kununurra is paradise, however there is an extreme price to pay to live there – when you add the cost of travel on top of out local rates, the cost of fuel and housing, it is no wonder Kununurra appears to be going backwards, rather than forwards.

Kununurra should be a tourism hub. We should be promoting our agriculture, river, water, lake, fishing, waterfalls, landscape and community events. It is without doubt that we do not get as many opportunities to do so, due to the costs associated to getting there.

The town has a huge number of government employees, who are all receiving isolated allowanced and travel allowances, however fore those not employed within the government sector, or those not employed at all may find is unaffordable to travel more than once a year. I am employed on decent salary however cannot afford the \$2000.00 round trip to get home (more than twice a year).

For myself to fly home this weekend (28.07.2017 – 1.08.2017), return from Mackay It would cost me \$2109.20 and over 15hrs travel each way.

For me to fly home a month later (25.08.2017 - 29.08.2017) it would \$1809.54, with 14hours travel each way.

I am flying home for my brothers wedding in 3 weeks time, I booked this flight 5 months in advance and my journey involves:

- 2 hour drive from South Walker Creek (Nebo Qld) to Mackay
- 4.5 hour drive from Mackay to Townsville
- 3.5hour flight Townsville to Darwin
- 1 x night accommodation in Darwin
- 1.0hour flight Darwin to Kununurra

#### Return

55 min flight Kununurra to Darwin

- 1 x Night accommodation in Darwin
- 3.5 hour flight Darwin to Townsville
- 4.5hour drive from Townsville to Mackay

The flights were on special for \$700, 5months ago however to book them today, it would cost \$1114.

Please consider that I also have to wear the following costs to get the cheapest fair I could find:

- Fuel and wear/tear on my Vehicle on the travel to /from Townsville
- Airport Parking for the period that I am away
- Additional time off work (1 x day for travel)
