I first read about this committee and the legislation for the Animal Welfare Amendment Bill 2017, when I was glancing through the morning paper.

I then read through a website headed "Division 3- Cruelty and other inhumane and improper treatment of animals".

"19. Cruelty to animals

(1) A person must not be cruel to an animal.

Penalty: Minimum - \$2000.00

Maximum - \$50,000 and imprisonment for 5 years."

To say I was horrified at such a lenient sentence would be an enormous understatement.
