Appointment of Consultant

- BMW will determine the scope of service and estimate the Perth price feeable value according to the pre-determined fee scales.
- Select a preferred consultant firm from the pre-qualified list. Contact the Consultant Firm's Representative to discuss the nature of the contract, the proposed scope of work, project timelines, fee proposal and availability of the nominated personnel.
- If the availability criteria are met and the fee basis acceptable, BMW will issue an Invitation for Offer letter that includes a project scope and contract conditions. See the Works Knowledge Portal for letter template.
- For projects lacking scope definition, BMW may authorise a selected firm to undertake further investigations on an hourly rates basis prior to establishing a firm scope and lump sum fee.
- Approval of the consultant Fee Proposal will result in BMW issuing an Acceptance of Offer letter. See the Works Knowledge Portal for letter template.
- A Process and Approval form is forwarded to Contract Development Manager, Policy and Practice, Building Industry Liaison to record the contract details on a database for consideration for future contracts. See the Works Knowledge Portal for the template form.

Handy Tips for Consultant Selection

- Select a preferred firm from the panel by considering the following criteria:
 - Locality of firm for regional projects
 - Expertise and experience
 - o Firm's and key personnel capability
 - o Firms capacity to undertake the work and availability of key personnel
 - o Past performance and suitability to the particular project
 - Value of work received through the panel relative to size of the firm
- Review the Panel Usage Stats spreadsheet to see the analysis of projects previously awarded to firms as shown on **Works Knowledge Portal**
- Review the Consultant Performance Report for previous project work undertaken at BMW
- Seek advice from your work colleagues/manager
