I Believe in a time when the sustainability of marine fish stocks are coming under increased pressure from recreational and commercial fishing, alternatives such as the stocking of drinking water supply dams to be an option in ensuring the health of our marine fish stocks. As a resident of a South Eastern suburb a short drive from several water supply dams, I would be very happy to spend more time freshwater fishing closer to home, rather than having to drive further to ocean fishing locations.
